

Polaris VIN (Vehicle Identification Number)

When requesting parts or technical information for your vehicle always quote your VIN.

Polaris vehicles use the industry standard of a 17-digit VIN:

- The first 3 characters identify the manufacturer of the vehicle
- Digits 4-8: Are the vehicle attributes
- Digit 9: Is a check digit
- Digit 10: Is Model Year
- Digit 11: Is plant code
- Digits 12-17: Are sequential numbers

For units that are older than 1999 the VIN's are 7 digits long. The 2nd and 3rd digits indicate the year.

ATV VIN Location

- ATV VINs stickers are generally located on the riders right side on the ATV.
- VIN stamps are generally located on the left front or rear frame rail.



Ranger VIN Location

 Ranger VIN's generally are located on the lower front left hand side of the unit.



RZR VIN Location

- RZR 570/800/900/1000 VIN stickers are generally located on the front frame tube on the riders right side right next to the front right shock/spring.
- RZR 570/800/900/1000 VIN stamps are generally located on the rear frame tube near left rear tire.





RZR VIN Location cont.

 RZR 170 VIN stickers are generally located in the riders left front wheel well on the frame tube.
